Static display: An ATR 72-600 in the colors of the Brazilian airline Azul will be on display in the static area of the exhibition. Since its launch at the end of 2007, the ATR 72-600 has become the best-selling regional aircraft with less than 90 seats worldwide. The aircraft is equipped with a new glass cockpit avionics suite and the new "Armonia" cabin created by the Italian industrial designer Giugiaro. The cabin features with the very latest technological passenger comfort innovations.

A DeLorean DMC, concept-car designed by Giugiaro and synonymous with the "Back to the Future" films will also be on display in the static area, next to the ATR 72-600, to symbolize the return of propeller-driven aircraft as the future technology for regional aviation.
