To further showcase the aircraft's adaptability and reliability, an ATR 72-600 will participate in the **daily flying display** throughout the forum. Recognised as the lowest-emission aircraft in the regional market, ATR turboprops emit **45% less CO2** than similar-size regional jets. Committed to shaping the future of sustainable regional aviation, ATR is actively engaged in multiple initiatives aiming at accelerating the industry's transition towards more responsible air travel.
